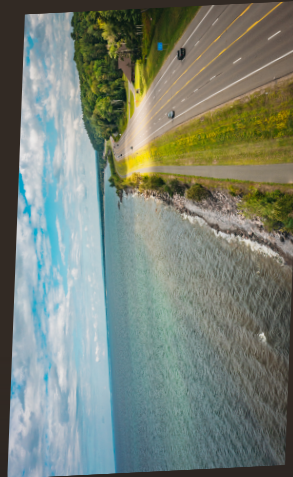

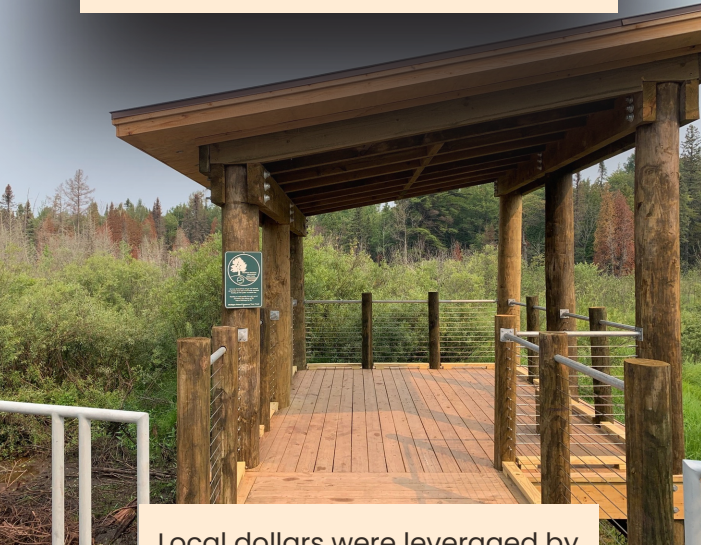

- **INTERPRETIVE ART**



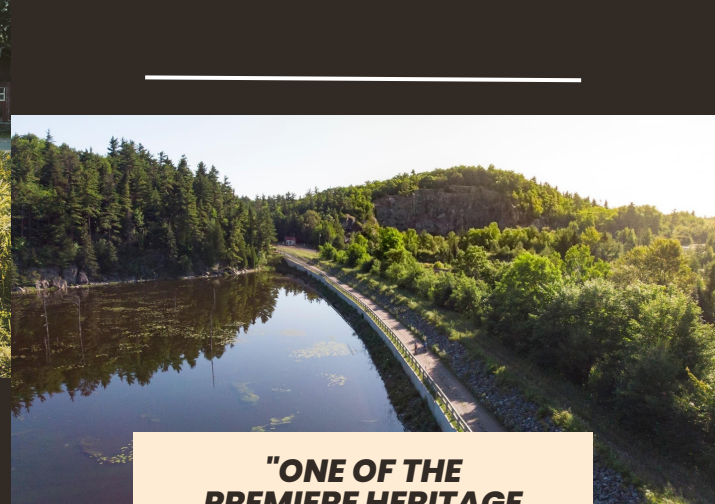
WHAT'S NEXT?

- Singletrack IOHT bike park and single track parallel to IOHT where possible
- Trail lighting from Ishpeming to Negaunee
- Winthrop Junction ORV Trailhead



- Enhanced trailhead at Negaunee Ice Arena
- More interpretive signs, bike racks, artwork
- Continued maintenance
