PUBLIC COMMENT (Agenda Items - Limit to three minutes)- Dan Korhonen on behalf of Connect Marquette's Iron Range Roll; expressed appreciation for permitting the IRR to use the IOHT as it primary corridor; indicated proceeds are used to benefit the YMCA of Marquette County Youth Programming and has raised over \$40,000 since the start 9 years ago; this year will celebrate the 10th running of the event on June 3, 2024
- APPROVAL OF CONSENT AGENDA: Bussone motions to accept; Hoffman supports: vote Ш. and motion carries
 - A. November minutes: approved as presented
 - B. Bills to be Paid: Payroll \$8420 combined, \$2775 paid in taxes, Bills to be paid \$1888
- APPROVAL OF FINANCIAL REPORTS: short discussion to approve the new financial IV. report format but eliminate the quarterly P&L comparison to actual income report due to redundancy with the annual and month P&L comparisons. Bussone motions to accept; Hoffman supports; vote and motion carries. Report consists of balance sheet showing assets of \$812,401; liabilities of \$188,982 and equity of \$623,820. Profit & loss at the end of November: General Revenue \$367,274 (100.4% of budget), Gross Profit \$561,535 (103.2% of budget), Total Expenses \$425,428 (58.1% of budget), Net Income \$136,074 (-72.6% of budget this is due to grant projects not happening in 2023 that were expected to start or be completed)
