- VI. OLD BUSINESS
 - A. Project Updates:
 - Koski Property Acquisition
 - a. Meet with NTN to discuss site plan, Leach will be IOHRA board rep involved with discussion; a 3 to 5 year plan will be discussed for trail development on the land
 - Negaunee Boardwalk
 - Pylons are in, trail corridor cleared, waiting for decking from manufacturer: current estimate sees the project completion by the end of August
 - Negaunee ORV Trail Extension
 - a. Land purchase complete, clearing to begin on approach to culvert crossing:
 Associated Constructors will move forward with the project after the boardwalk is completed
 - 4. Lakenenland Extension
 - a. Co Rd BAA Abandonment vs widen existing trail and creating a divider: the amount of time and cost that would be required for abandonment would not be workable with the timeline/budget of the extension project; beard directed the project to widen the existing corridor and include a divider between the motorized and non-motorized route: motion by Leach to support widening the current corridor and dividing the trail between motorized and non-motorized, supported by Becker, ayes- all

VII. NEW BUSINESS

- U.P. State Bank CD Maturity on July 30-move to UP State Bank saving account, Leach motions to transfer the money to a savings account at UP State Bank, Hoffman supports, ayes- all
- Approval of Associated Constructors Payment #1 for Marshland Boardwalk: Leach motions to approve payment, Bussone seconds, ayes- all
- Support for Negaunee EO Campsite Pilot Project: Becker motions to support project, Bussone seconds, aves-all
- Joe Contance would like to discuss an interpretative panel for Founder's Landing in Marquette, they would be interested in funding it: board recommended to open dialogue with the group

and see what the project would consist, costs and working with the City of Marquette for the needed approval

- 5. Millage Committee Report: Republic Millage Flyer; present example of what is being done to promote the millage request in Republic, emphasizing the .197 mills translates to .197 cents per \$1000 of accessed property value, total cost is \$10-\$20 per year; money to support local projects within each municipality and leverage additional grant money from Michigan Trust Fund and Recreation Passport grants
- 6. Discussion: What qualifies as an event & types of e-vehicles on IOHT (one-wheels, scooters, ect): discussion evolved around the IOHRA does not have enforcement and should focus on trail etiquette, IOHRA isn't in the position to regulate trail users only to follow State of Michigan regulations, regarding what qualifies as an event discussion was to look in to what the MIDNR considers an event and how is that is determined; discussion also included the benefits and drawbacks of having a "Hold Harmless" document for non-event gatherings and to create a policy that defines an event (number of participants, monetary gain, ect)

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VIII. ADMINISTRATOR REPORT: Gate vandalism at Stoneville Rd crossing, complaint of gate width on Wawanowin Road (measurement 69", other gates from 71" to 73" max width of ORV 65"), prepare supplemental material for Winthrop Jct Trailhead Rec Passport grant application.

IX. BOARD COMMENT:

Leach: Local trail groups emphasizing trail etiquette, perhaps an opportunity to piggy back or help reinforce the message, also Negaunee Township is looking for old forge tools to incorporate into their new playground signage

Becker: running to fill a partial term on the City of Negaunee council and will be on the November ballot

Hoffman: received concern about wayfinding along the IOHT; some are need to be addressed, eg Spring Street, Marquette, Healy/Co Rd 480 in Negaunee, leaving Ishpeming crossing Business M-28 to the Ishpeming Senior Center

Mike Springer: appreciates the conference camera, feels the discussion of different types of electric vehicles on the IOHT will be an ever evolving discussion, mentioned a new program call "Safe Routes to Parks" but currently hasn't heard of any funding options to support it, also encouraged exploring "Safe Routes to Schools" program which may be beneficial to the IOHRA, invited the board to a ribbon cutting in Big Bay for the dedication for the interpretive panels installed there
