IRON ORE HERITAGE RECREATION AUTHORITY MONTHLY BOARD MEETING MINUTES WEDNESDAY, NOVEMBER 20, 2024, 4:30pm Ishpeming Multi-purpose Senior Center, Ishpeming

- I. ROLL CALL: present- Don Britton, Nick Leach, Jon Becker, Larry Bussone excussed absent- Dawn Hoffman, Glenn Johnson; guests- Diane Gauthier from Go Get Outside
- II. PUBLIC COMMENT (Agenda Items Limit to three minutes): none
- III. APPROVAL OF CONSENT AGENDA: Becker motions to approve, Bussone seconds, aye all A. March Minutes
 - B. Bills to be Paid
- IV. APPROVAL OF FINANCIAL REPORTS: Bussone motions to approve, Leach seconds, aye all
- V. IOHT Event Approval:
 - A. Ishpeming Turkey Trot, November 28 hosted by Go Get Outside: Diane Gauthier presented the trail use permit for the 12th Annual Ishpeturkey Trot which is a fundraiser for a school food assistance program for area students. Bussone motions to approve permit, Becker seconds, aye all
- VI. APPROVAL OF AGENDA: Hendrickson requested a subtopic to New Business 1; Nicolet CD maturing Bussone motions to approve agenda w/ subtopic, Leach seconds, ayes all
- VII. OLD BUSINESS
 - A. Updates:
- Negaunee Boardwalk
 - a. CN Railroad installed a new culvert; boardwalk no longer flooded: Hendrickson presented updated drone footage which showed the CN Railroad culvert work and the current water level which is back to reasonable levels
- Negaunee ORV Trail Extension
 - a. Bottomless culvert installed; trail bypass connected: Britton requested that we bring in stone to cap the topsoil on the northeast side of the bypass; Hendrickson indicated that there are still remaining trail maintenance funds in the budget; the trails will need to be barriered so motorized traffic doesn't use the previous (non-motorized) snowmobile route
- 3. Lakenenland Extension
 - a. Timeline, wetlands management plan submitted to EGLE: Hendrickson presented the 2025 timeline provided by Coleman Engineering which is: finalize permits and plans by January 31; Request for Bids goes out March 1; Construction Starts Latest by May 1 (as requested by the IOHRA board); Project completed July 15

- 4. Millage passed all three townships, need to plan for board succession
 - a. Discuss Friends of IOHT for future millage & community engagement: Hendrickson will attend the December township board meetings, Ely, Humboldt and Republic. Will start onboarding the townships with the Recreation Authority Act; IOHRA Articles of Incorporation and Bylaws. The timeline would be to have selections made at their February board meeting and invite the representatives to attend the March meeting as guests in preparation for the handoff at the April 2025 Annual Meeting. Hendrickson will also contact the City of Marquette and Marquette County to start their process for replacing City Rep Leach and appoint the odd number board member from the County.
 Becker also brought up the concept of Friends of IOHT group to advocate for future millages, next millage being 2028.

VIII. NEW BUSINESS

- 1. IOHRA 2025 Budget Proposal: general discussion how well the previous budget worked, only made one amendment in October; insurance was a discussion point, along with adding a new category for the IOHT Maintenance Truck; the proposed 2025 budget will have approximately \$150,000 deficit due to the Lakenenland Extension which has been planned for: Leach recommended tabling the budget until December were we'll have more board input and a chance for Hendrickson give it another review.
 - Nicolet Bank CD: Leach motions to give Hendrickson the authority to reinvest it in another CD depending on terms and return shop around for 6 months at 4.5% return, Britton seconds, aye all
- Request to attend International Trail Summit- Madison, Wisconsin on April 14-17, 2025:
 Hendrickson submitted a request to attend the summit which bring together trial organizations and builders from across the country and internationally, it was suggested by Carol Fulsher that it would be a good opportunity to meet peer groups and get first hand experience with other organizations along with a good networking opportunity, Leach motions to send Hendrickson to the Trail Summit, Becker seconds, all aye
- 3. Accept Laura MacDonald's IOHRA appointment to represent Negaunee Township: MacDonald was approved at the Negaunee Township Meeting on November 14; MacDonald would fill the partial term for AI Reynolds' seat until March 31, 2025, and then need to be reappointed in April. In additional a brief discussion on the new board members coming aboard along with out-going board member replacement and restaging board seat terms to create alternating appointments going forward. Leach motions to accept MacDonald's appointment, Becker seconds, aye all
- IX. ADMINISTRATOR REPORT: Contributions to the Jim Thomas Memorial: 15 donations for \$895 to date; issues with Electric Outdoor pilot camping unit resolved with the Health Department, letter of support written to the City of Negaunee to continue the project, in Spring 2025 readdress it with the City of Negaunee; Winthrop Junction Recreation Passport Grant application score improved by 35pts to 135, most likely will not get the grant but will be more prepared for the next round; Britton suggested submitting the grant one more time with improvements and if we don't get it move on to the next project which would be most likely be the Negaunee Ice Arena Trailhead
- X. BOARD COMMENT: Leach reported to the board that he and Hendrickson met with Jim Thompson at the Great Lake Wood Products property in Negaunee Township, he is proposing selling 15 acres on the back of the property to the IOHRA which adjoins the Koski Forst Property acquired this year, look at it for a possible acquisition in the future, Britton recommend committing to the Koski Forest Property first then look at possible expansion, Bussone brought up we are still considering the O'Dovero property Leach will inquire with Township assessor on current market value as just land; Leach will get back with Thompson that it was discussed and will be a future consideration; Britton indicated that he will get with Tom Lakenenland regarding the timeline for the extension
